## Monday Night Rehearsals

Monday night rehearsals start tomorrow (August 9<sup>th</sup>). We will rehearse from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. on the field. Please make sure you are on the field ready to start at 6:30 p.m. Students need to continue to bring their own water bottle/jug as it will still be warm in the evening. Monday night rehearsals are important because it is one of the few times during our rehearsal schedule where we can get some of our additional staff members at the rehearsal since most of them cannot attend our 7 a.m. rehearsals. These rehearsals are required and points are given towards their grade. If students have conflicts with Monday night rehearsals and another activity they need to meet with me individually and we will come up with a plan on how to handle it. This week will be starting our Opener pass-off and finishing up the pass-offs for the warm-ups (which were due during camp). Students who have not completed their required pass-offs prior to the first performance may be held out of the performance.

### Forms and Fees Night/OE Open House

On Thursday, August 19<sup>th</sup> we will be having our Forms and Fees Night in conjunction with the OE Open House. The band room will be open from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. for parents to come and take care of their forms. We have mandatory forms that are required by KSHSAA and the Olathe School District for participation in our activity. This is a great way to get them knocked out all at once and checked off of your to-do-list. Once again, students who have not turned in their paper work will not be allowed to participate in the first performance. I waiting to get the 2021 forms from the District, and will email them out this week before hand so that you can fill them out before arriving if you would like.

With regards to fees, the only required fees are the cost of the marching shoes and gloves. The boosters ask for a suggested contribution as well. This is not required, but is how we fund a large portion of the booster activities. If you cannot afford the entire amount at once we accept it in payments spread out over the year or later in the year. We are thankful for anything that families are able to contribute. We recognize that the pandemic has put some families in very tough financial situations, which is why we do not call it a fee or require payment. I will be sending a cost breakdown sheet with the forms later this week.

## **Booster Meeting**

On August 24<sup>th</sup> we will be holding our first booster meeting of the year. I think many parents will benefit from attending the booster meeting since we have so many students who are new to "real" marching band. At this meeting as part of my director's report I will take the time to explain in more detail what some of the events on the marching calendar are and how they work (can parents attend, how long do they last, where are they at, do they cost, etc.). This will truly be the best way to be plugged in and understand what is happening with marching band. At all booster meetings this year I will also provide updated information about our impending trip to L.A. in March.
