## Parents and Students:

I hope that you have all been enjoying a fantastic summer! I wanted to send out a few reminders and updates for camp and the season.

- A reminder that Saturday evening from 6 to 8 p.m. we will be having an open house for Mrs. Creek. This is a come and go event and gives parents and students a chance to say thank you to Mrs. Creek for her 13 years at Olathe East.
- For camp, a reminder that we keep the same schedule as pre-camp: Outside from 7 to 11 a.m. and inside from 1 to 3:30 p.m. for music rehearsals. Students need to remember to hydrate not just at camp but all day and evening to prepare for the next day. Lunch will still be an "open" lunch where students may stay and eat at school or go home or go out to eat. This lunch period is unsupervised as staff will be meeting or out to eat as well. Similar to pre-camp please make sure to have tennis shoes with laces, sunscreen, and anything else you need to be successful. - Thursday, July 27<sup>th</sup> and Friday, July 28<sup>th</sup>- Full camp continues for all members
- Saturday, July 29<sup>th</sup>- Camp Carwash at Meyer Music. We will go over section report times at camp, but they are not the same as pre-camp. Everything else is just like the one at pre-camp
- Monday, July 31<sup>st</sup> and August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup>- Full camp continues for all members
- Friday, August 4<sup>th</sup>- All members rehearse for the morning session from 7 to 11 a.m.-Only Leadership Team returns in the afternoon to setup for the BBQ and performance.
- Friday, August 4<sup>th</sup>- End of camp performance with the Orange and Blue BBQ and silent auction. Doors open at 5:30 p.m. and the performance starts at 6:00 p.m. This is our single biggest fundraiser for the year. Please help us start the year in a good financial position by attending this event! This is the first performance of the year for the marching band and is a required performance for all members.
- A reminder for all students that your homework for the summer was to get your warm-ups memorized by the time you show up to camp in July.
