Things to remember:

- Please be on time or early for performances. Arrive one hour before your scheduled time to make sure you have time to park, find the warm-up room, find your performance room, etc.
- The highway to Washburn Rural is very tricky. If you miss the correct exit, you will be stuck on a highway with no exits for 30 miles. We have had students and parents in the past miss their performance because of this mistake. Please pay close attention to the exits.
- Ratings will be posted in the hallway leading east away from the office on the windows that face north. I would expect a delay of two hours after you perform. We will have judges' sheets available on Monday.
- A concession stand will be available near the main entrance of the school. Cash or Venmo only! No food or drink items allowed in the gyms, performance areas, or warm-up rooms. Please keep all food and drink in the cafeteria/commons or outside.
- After your performance is finished, please wait outside the door to your performance room and make sure you pick up your judges' copy of your music. Before arriving make sure that you write your name and Olathe East High School on the front of your judges copy to help the door monitor.
- Warm-up rooms are available in the C and D hallways off the commons area. There are also 6 warm-up rooms available on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the band room, B139. Students may also warm up inside Gym A off the commons area. Please limit the time spent in the practice rooms to 5 minutes. Be courteous and share the space. Some rooms have keyboards while others don't.
- Don't forget to communicate with your accompanist about your solo time and location, we do not do this for you.
- Percussion students remember you are responsible for the instruments you transported at Regionals. We need those instruments returned to the band room by 8:00 a.m. on Monday for rehearsal, please do not leave them in your car!
