### **Marching Band/Drumline**

**Thanks** for the support of all the parents that helped in any way to make all three performances a success last week. I am extremely proud of how well the students performed at all three events. We are off to a great start!!

- Report time will once again be 5:00 p.m. on Thursday for the game this week. Students should wear their dry fit shirt for this performance.
- Saturday's schedule is as follows: Report time for students is noon (they should eat lunch before they come). Bus will leave for Students should wear shorts and their dry fit shirt. They should also bring their own large water bottle with them as it is going to be a warm rehearsal and we will take several water breaks. We will rehearse from 1:00 to 3:30 and then will perform our 2022 Parent Preview Performance at 3:30 in the bleachers at CBAC.
