Grade Questions:

Since grades have gone into the gradebook, there have been a few questions about what they reflect. The main items that may be causing a grade drop for your student are easily taken care of with some student initiative:

1. Forms: Instructions for filling out forms have been sent home in multiple emails and are attached to this email as well. Students must fill out the two ONLINE forms for Transportation Permission and the Substance Abuse Policy and must hand in PAPER copies of the Band Policy Agreement and their Medical Release form. Again, specific instructions for how to do this are attached to this email. These are tied to a grade because students CANNOT perform with the band until all forms are submitted

- 2. Pass Off Grades: Students that receive a "0" on their pass off test did not make any attempt to take their pass off test. Students that received a "5" on their test have made an attempt, but did not quite have everything fully memorized yet. All students that have not fully passed of their music are responsible for setting up a time to pass their music for Ms. Fillingham as soon as they are able. I am happy to change those grades to a 10/10 as soon the music is passed, but students must make the effort to do so!
- 3. **Tardies/Unexcused absences:** Any unexcused tardy or absence from rehearsal will result in a lowered participation grade. Please do communicate with Ms. Fillingham or Mr. Reed about any extenuating circumstances that are causing excessive tardies or absences, as we do take those things into account!
- 4. Lack of rehearsal materials: Students that consistently do not have their basic rehearsal materials (music, drill, pencil, field markers, instrument, mallets, sticks, etc.) or who leave them scattered around the band room for others to clean up will lose daily participation points.

One more thing, just to make it clear in case there is any confusion—no student's grade is tied to whether or not they have paid their band fees. We appreciate those of you that have taken care of that and hope others will do the same, but students do NOT gain or lose any grade points due to band fees.

All District Band/Sousa Band Auditions:

Olathe East has a long history of placing many students in the All District bands. I HIGHLY encourage all students to be working on the all district band music, which can be found linked here: https://ksmea.org/hsband/excerpts/. Students that are enrolled for wind ensemble are expected to audition, and will be tested over this material during the last week of October. Auditions are on November 8.

Any freshman interested in auditioning for Sousa band can find the music linked here: http://ks-sousahonorband.org/how-to-apply/. Recorded auditions must be submitted to Ms. Fillingham no later than October 15.

Home Football Game—Sep 4, Call time 5:00 PM:

Students will arrive in their DRI-FIT and be sure to have long black socks. All hair below chin length will need to be up away from the face and off the neck, and longer hair should be in a bun. Buses will leave at 5:30 for CBAC.
